Disabilities At Work to Launch Live Internet Talk Radio Show

Trenton, NJ, March 8, 2010 – Disabilities At Work (DAW) is gearing up to launch its Internet Talk Radio Show on the VoiceAmerica Business Channel. Disabilities At Work Radio will focus on broad areas of interest to people with disabilities, their advocates, and employers. The hour-long show debuts on Wednesday, April 14 at Noon EST and will air every Wednesday thereafter.

DAW Radio spotlights businesses that support people with disabilities through philanthropy, or that go beyond compliance in finding and hiring qualified people with disabilities. The show features corporate VIPs, successful service providers, educators, people with disabilities who have interesting stories, authors, researchers, government officials, elected representatives, and celebrities who have reasons to be involved.
